9 Norris Green in recognition of his exemplary record of
10 achievement and dedicated service to the people of the State
11 of Alabama during a distinguished career spanning 39 years;

13 WHEREAS, he is retiring from his position as
14 Director of the Alabama Legislative Fiscal Office, having
15 served with exceptional capability in that capacity following
16 his unanimous appointment by the Joint Fiscal Committee of the
17 Legislature in 2012; and

18 WHEREAS, one year after the inception of the
19 Legislative Fiscal Office, his employment began in 1976 as a

7 WHEREAS, an ardent advocate for non-partisan service
8 to all legislators, he has forged innovative approaches to
9 financial dilemmas to satisfy the goals and objectives of
10 legislators, while accommodating the fiscal needs of state
11 agencies and other entities; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Green's superior expertise in state
13 pensions, taxation and reform, health insurance programs, and
14 state budget-related constitutional issues and challenges and
15 his ability to translate complicated financial concepts into
16 discernible information for diverse audiences has garnered him
