4	SJR AFFIRMING THE STATE OF ALABAMA'S CONTINUED SUPPORT OF
5	THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN RECOGNIZING ISRAEL AS A
6	SOVEREIGN NATION.

8	WHEREAS, in the aftermath of World War II, the United
9	States, along with the United Nations, recognized a need for
10	the Jewish People to reestablish their historic homeland; in
11	1947, the United Nations General Assembly voted for the
12	establishment of two states in Palestine and the United
13	States supported the relocation of Holocaust survivors to
14	Palestine; and
15	WHEREAS, on May 14, 1948, at midnight, the
16	Provisional Government of Israel proclaimed a new State of
17	Israel; President Harry Truman, on the same date, became the
18	first leader of a nation to recognize Israel as a sovereign
19	government and authority of the Jewish state; and
20	WHEREAS, since 1948, the United States, and the State
21	of Alabama, have continued to recognize the State of Israel
22	as an independent nation; and
23	WHEREAS, most recently, President Donald Trump
24	relocated the U.S. Embassy to Jerusalem, thereby recognizing
25	the city as the capital of Israel; and
26	WHEREAS, Hamas was founded with a charter, including
27	stated goals of the destruction of Israel and murder of

Jews, and has been designated by the United States and many

29	other nations as a Foreign Terrorist Organization; and
30	WHEREAS, on October 7, 2023, Hamas launched a massive
31	unprovoked war on Israel by air, land, and sea, firing
32	thousands of rockets into the civilian population, and
33	launching a planned genocidal rampage murdering and
34	abducting Jews by raiding civilian homes and streets,
35	slaughtering innocent men, women, children, babies, the
36	elderly, and families with extreme cruelty, including
37	gang-rape, sexual violence, torture, mutilation, execution,
38	decapitation, burning alive, and other unspeakable acts; and
39	WHEREAS, targeting the 50th anniversary of the Yom
40	Kippur War, the October 7, 2023, attacks represent the
41	deadliest and most savage assault and brutal massacre of
42	Jews since the Holocaust, including vicious atrocities,
43	shocking barbarism, and vile crimes against humanity, and
4 4	Hamas officials have publicly stated it is only the first of
45	more to come; and
46	WHEREAS, Alabama and Israel share a commitment to
47	deeply held common values from the history of each shaped
48	greatly through the influence of Biblical faith, in addition
49	to many nationally shared values as the only democratic ally
50	of the United States in the Middle East; and
51	WHEREAS, the State of Alabama is an unequivocal
52	supporter of the State of Israel and its right to defend
53	itself against terror, aggression, and threat to the safety
54	of its citizens; and
55	WHEREAS, the State of Alabama is committed to the
56	welfare security and survival of the State of Israel and



- 57 supports its legal, historical, and moral right to
- independence and self-determination in the ancestral
- 59 homeland of the Jewish People; and
- 60 WHEREAS, the State of Alabama recognizes that all
- 61 life is sacred, and every life lost is tragic and to be
- avoided, and remains committed to a future where the State
- of Israel and all her neighbors can live in peace, with
- 64 mutual recognition of each other's dignity and sovereignty;

- 66 WHEREAS, state officials and institutions have a
- 67 responsibility to protect citizens from acts of hate and
- 68 bigotry motivated by discriminatory animus and must be given
- 69 the tools to do so; and
- 70 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
- 71 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That this body continues to
- 72 support the United States in its affirmation of the
- 73 independent and sovereign Nation of Israel and:
- 74 (a) Honors the memory of the innocent lives lost and
- 75 commits to never forget the unwarranted and unjustified
- 76 vicious assault on Israel and the Jewish People on October
- 77 7, 2023.
- 78 (b) Condemns Hamas and all those who support their
- 79 violent, genocidal, and hateful acts globally, in the
- 80 United States, and in the State of Alabama.
- 81 (c) Reaffirms unequivocal support for the State of
- 82 Israel as a Jewish state, recognizes that the Jewish People
- 83 are indigenous to the land of Israel, condemns all attacks
- on the people of Israel, supports Israel's right to engage



- in lawful acts of self-defense, opposes all attempts to economically and politically isolate Israel within the
- international arena, and opposes all efforts to assault the
- 88 legitimacy of Israel as the sovereign homeland of the Jewish
- 89 People.
- 90 (d) Stands with Israel and the Jewish People as they
- 91 defend themselves and ensure the future safety of the
- 92 Israeli people after the barbaric massacre and war initiated
- 93 by Hamas and others to brutally violate, terrorize,
- 94 slaughter, and ethnically cleanse the land of Jews.
- 95 (e) Rejects the claims that Jews are colonizers in
- 96 their ancestral homeland, or occupiers in the land to which
- 97 they are indigenous, with testimony including more than
- 98 3,000 years of archaeology and history.
