23	SECTION 1. Arkansa	as Code § 5-73-322 is amended	to read as follows:

26	(a) As used in thi	is section:	
27	(1) "Hospita	al" means the facilities of a	n institution licensed,
28	certified, or approved by	y the Division of Health Faci	lities Services of the
29	Department of Health as a	a hospital that is primarily	engaged in providing to
30		therapeutic services for medi	_
31	_	ersons with an injury, disabi	
32		a physician or other medical	
33		"Public university, public	college, or community
34	college" means an institu		
35		(i) Regularly receives budge	tary support from the
36	state government;		

1	(ii) is part of the university of Arkansas or		
2	Arkansas State University systems; or		
3	(iii) Is required to report to the Arkansas Higher		
4	Education Coordinating Board.		
5	(B) "Public university, public college, or community		
6	college" includes without limitation a public technical institute in a count		
7	with a population of at least two hundred thousand (200,000) according to the		
8	last federal decennial census and that borders another state.		
9	(B)(C) "Public university, public college, or community		
10	college" does not include a private university or private college solely		
11	because:		
12	(i) Students attending the private university or		
13	private college receive state-supported scholarships; or		
14	(ii) The private university or private college		
15	voluntarily reports to the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board; and		
16	(2)(3)(A) "Staff member" means a person who is not enrolled as a		
17	full-time student at the university, college, or community college and is		
18	either employed by the university, college, or community college:		
19	(i) full Full time; or is on		
20	(ii) On a nine-month or twelve-month appointment at		
21	the university, college, or community college as a faculty member; or		
22	(iii) As a part-time faculty member at the		
23	university, college, or community college.		
24	(B) "Staff member" does not include a graduate assistant.		
25	(b) A licensee may possess a concealed handgun in the buildings and on		
26	the grounds, whether owned or leased by the public university, public		
27	college, or community college, of the public university, public college, or		
28	community college where he or she is employed unless otherwise prohibited by		
29	this section or § 5-73-306 if he or she is a staff member.+		
30	(1) He or she is a staff member; and		
31	(2)(A) The governing board of the public university, public		
32	college, or community college does not adopt a policy expressly disallowing		
33	the carrying of a concealed handgun by staff members in the buildings or on		
34	the grounds of the public university, public college, or community college		
35	and posts notices as described in § 5-73-306(18).		
36	(B) A governing board of the public university, public		

- college, or community college may adopt differing policies for the carrying
 of a concealed handgun by staff members for different campuses, areas of a
 campus, or individual buildings of the public university, public college, or
- 4 community college for which the governing board is responsible.
- (C) A policy disallowing the carrying of a concealed
 handgun by staff members into the public university, public college, or
 community college expires one (1) year after the date of adoption and must be
 readopted each year by the governing board of the public university, public
 college, or community college to remain in effect.
 - (c) A licensee may possess a concealed handgun in the buildings and on the grounds of the private university or private college where he or she is employed unless otherwise prohibited by <u>this section or</u> § 5-73-306 if:
 - (1) He or she is a staff member; and

- (2)(A) The private university or private college does not adopt a policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun in the buildings and on the grounds of the private university or private college and posts notices as described in § 5-73-306(18).
- (B) A private university or private college that adopts a policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun in the buildings and on the grounds of the private university or private college shall post notices as described in § 5-73-306(18).
- (C) A private university or private college that adopts a policy only allowing carrying of a concealed handgun under this section shall post notices as described in § 5-73-306(18) and subsection (k) of this section.
 - (d) The storage of a handgun in a university or college-operated student dormitory or residence hall is prohibited under § 5-73-119(c).
- (e)(1) The governing board of a public university, public college, or public community college that operates a public medical school may adopt a policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun by a staff member in the buildings or on the grounds of the public medical school that are adjacent to or are up to within a radius of one-half (1/2) mile of an associated public hospital.
 - (2) This subsection does not limit the governing board of a public university, public college, or public community college from tailoring its policy to permit the carrying of a concealed handgun into certain public

1 hospital or public medical school facilities within the one-half-mile radius. 2 (3) A policy adopted under this subsection is invalid until 3 public notices as described under § 5-73-306(18) are posted in and around the 4 premises of the public medical school and associated public hospital that are 5 subject to the policy. 6 (f)(1) The governing board of a public university, public college, or 7 public community college may adopt a policy expressly disallowing the 8 carrying of a concealed handgun by a staff member in the buildings or on the 9 grounds of the public university, public college, or public community college 10 that are adjacent to or are up to within a radius of one-half (1/2) mile of a 11 federally owned and operated presidential library. 12 (2) This subsection does not limit the governing board of a 13 public university, public college, or public community college from tailoring 14 its policy to permit the carrying of a concealed handgun into certain 15 facilities where carrying a concealed handgun is not otherwise prohibited by 16 federal law within the one-half-mile radius. 17 (3) A policy adopted under this subsection is invalid until 18 public notices as described under § 5-73-306(18) are posted in and around the 19 premises of the public university, public college, or public community 20 college that are adjacent to or up to within a radius of one-half (1/2) mile 21 of a federally owned and operated presidential library that are subject to 22 the policy. 23 (g) A policy disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun under 24 subsection (e) or subsection (f) of this section expires one (l) year after 25 the date of adoption and shall be readopted each year by the governing board 26 to remain in effect. 27 (h)(l) A staff member who is a licensee and who may carry a concealed handgun on the campus of a public university, public college, or public 28 29 community college under this section may not carry a concealed handgun: 30 (A) Into a licensed daycare or childcare facility that is located on the campus of the public university, public college, or public 31 32 community college; 33 (B) Into a location during which an official meeting 34 lasting no more than (9) hours is being conducted in accordance with 35 documented grievance and disciplinary procedures as established by the public

university, public college, or public community college if:

3	(ii) Notice is posted on the door of or entryway

8	special event, or special meeting lasting no more than seventy-two (72)		
9	consecutive hours of a public university, public college, or community

13	prohibition against a staff member carrying a concealed handgun into the		
14	location during which a special function, special event, or special meeting		
15	is being held;		
16	(ii) There is a law enforcement presence equal to or		
17	greater than the larger of:		
18	(a) One (1) law enforcement officer per one		
19	hundred (100) people attending, or, if over ten thousand (10,000) people		
20	attending, one (1) law enforcement officer per five hundred (500) people		
21	attending, the official function, special event, or special meeting; or		
22	(b) One (1) law enforcement officer per seven		
23	thousand five hundred square feet (7,500 sq. ft.) of building or event area;		
24	(iii) At least twenty-four (24) hours' notice is		
25	given to participants of the official function, special event, or special		
26	meeting; and		
27	(iv) Temporary notice is posted on the door or		
28	entryway into the location in which the official function, special event, or		
29	special meeting is held that possession of a concealed handgun by a licensee		
30	under this section is prohibited during the official function, special event,		
31	or special meeting.		
32	(2) As used in this subsection, "special function, special		
33	event, or special meeting" does not include a regularly scheduled or ongoing		
34	event, such as a class at a public university, public college, or public		
35	community college.		
36	(3) A person who knowingly violates subdivision (h)(1) of this		

1	section upon conviction is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.			
2	(i) The governing board of a public university, public college, or			
3	public community college may prohibit a person possessing an out-of-state			
4	concealed handgun license that otherwise is valid in this state from carrying			
5	a concealed handgun on the property or in a building of a public university,			
6	public college, or public community college under this section.			
7	(j) This section does not affect a licensee's ability to store a			
8	concealed handgun in his or her vehicle under § 5-73-306(13)(B)(v).			
9	(k)(1) If a private university or private college permits carrying a			
10	concealed handgun under this section, the private university or private			
11	college may revise any sign or notice required to be posted under § 5-73-			
12	306(18) to indicate that carrying a concealed handgun under this section is			
13	permitted.			
14	(2) If a public university, public college, or community college			
15	permits the carrying of a concealed handgun under this section, the public			
16	university, public college, or community college shall place at each roadway			
17	entrance to the public university, public college, or community college a			
18	written notice clearly readable at a distance of not less than ten feet (10')			
19	that "carrying a concealed handgun in the buildings of this campus other than			
20	by licensed employees is prohibited".
