TO BE KNOWN AS THE "ARKANSAS SOVEREIGNTY ACT OF 2021"; CONCERNING THE RIGHT TO
BEAR ARMS IN THE STATE OF ARKANSAS; AND CONCERNING OTHER CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 298

Amend Senate Bill No. 298 as originally introduced:

Page 5, delete lines 16 through 25, and substitute the following:

"(2) The penalty for violating this subsection is a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) for each offense."

AND

Page 5, delete lines 30 through 36

AND

Page 6, delete lines 1 and 2, and substitute the following:

"(2) The penalty for violating this subsection is a fine of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each offense."

AND

Page 7, delete lines 28 through 36

AND

Page 8, delete line 1, and substitute the following:

"(2) The penalty for violating this subsection is a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) for each offense."

AND

Page 8, delete lines 6 through 14, and substitute the following:

"(2) The penalty for violating the rights described under subsection (a) of this section is a fine of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each offense."
