Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 62
Amend Senate Bill No. 62 as originally introduced:
Page 1, delete line 31 through 35, and substitute the following: "(1) "Boycott" means without an ordinary business purpose: (A) Engaging in refusals to deal; (B) Terminating business activities; or (C) Other actions that are intended to limit public
entities commercial relations with an industry in a discriminatory manner."
AND
Page 2, delete lines 6 and 7, and substitute the following: "(B) "Company" does not include a financial services provider as defined in § 25-1-1001(8)(A) as created by HB1307 of the Ninety- fourth General Assembly if that bill becomes an act;"
(3)(A) "Ordinary business purpose" means a purpose that is
related to business operations. (B) "Ordinary business purpose" does not include a purpose that is solely related to furthering social, political, or ideological
interests."
AND
Page 2, line 8, delete "(3)" and substitute "(4)"
AND
Page 3, delete lines 4 and 5 and substitute the following: "(2) Contracts with a total potential value of less than



seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000)."
