SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend the Judiciary Committee Report, dated March 27, 2024, page 2,
 2 line 12, strike "DUTIES;" and substitute "DUTIES. THIS SUBSECTION (2)(c)
 3 DOES NOT APPLY TO SECURITY PERSONNEL EMPLOYED OR RETAINED BY AN
 4 ELECTED OFFICIAL TO PROTECT THE ELECTED OFFICIAL WHILE ENGAGED IN
 5 THE PERSON'S OFFICIAL DUTIES AS SECURITY PERSONNEL."

6 Page 2, after line 34 insert:

7 "(a) "ELECTED OFFICIAL" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO IS SERVING IN
 8 AN ELECTED POSITION IN THE STATE OF COLORADO AT ANY LEVEL OF
 9 GOVERNMENT."

10 Page 2, line 42, strike "and (3)(j)" and substitute "(3)(j), and (4)".

11 Page 4, after line 19 insert:

12 "(4) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF SUBSECTION (3) OF
 13 THIS SECTION TO THE CONTRARY, SECURITY PERSONNEL EMPLOYED OR
 14 RETAINED BY AN ELECTED OFFICIAL, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 18-12-105.3,
 15 TO PROTECT THE ELECTED OFFICIAL SHALL NOT CARRY A FIREARM AT A
 16 LOCATION DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION WHILE ENGAGED IN THE PERSON'S
 17 OFFICIAL DUTIES AS SECURITY PERSONNEL."

18 Page 4, lines 21 and 22, strike "(3)(c) introductory portion, and (3)(c)(I)"
 19 and substitute "and (3)(c)".

20 Page 5, after line 10, insert:

21 "(II) A uniformed security guard employed by a contract security
 22 agency, as defined in section 24-33.5-415.4, acting within the scope of
 23 the authority granted by and in the performance of a contractual
 24 agreement for the provision of security services with a person or entity
 25 that owns or controls the facility, building, or location subject to this
 26 section. THIS SUBSECTION (3)(c)(II) DOES NOT APPLY TO SECURITY
 27 PERSONNEL EMPLOYED OR RETAINED BY AN ELECTED OFFICIAL, AS
 28 DEFINED IN SECTION 18-12-105.3, TO PROTECT THE ELECTED OFFICIAL
 29 WHILE ENGAGED IN THE PERSON'S OFFICIAL DUTIES AS SECURITY
 30 PERSONNEL."
