A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Chairman Phil Mendelson and Councilmember Kenyan R. McDuffie introduced the following bill which was referred to the Committee \_\_\_\_\_\_.

To amend the Firearms Control Regulations Act to establish a procedure for expiration and renewal of firearm registration certificates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Firearms Re-registration Requirement Amendment Act of 2016".

Sec. 2. Section 207a of the Firearms Control Regulations Act of 1975, effective September 24, 1976 (D.C. Law 1-85; D.C. Official Code § 7-2502.07a) is amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 207a. Expiration and renewal of registration certificate.

- "(a) Registration certificates shall expire 4 years after the date of issuance unless renewed in accordance with this section for subsequent 4-year periods.
- "(b) A registrant shall be eligible for renewal of registration of a firearm if the registrant continues to meet all of the initial registration requirements set forth in section 203(a) and follows any procedures the Chief may establish by rule.

39	(c)(1) For each renewal, a registrant shall submit a statement to the Metropolitan
40	Police Department attesting to:
41	"(A) Possession of the registered firearm;
42	"(B) The registrant's address; and
43	"(C) The registrant's continued compliance with all registration
44	requirements set forth in section 203(a).
45	"(2) The statement submitted pursuant to paragraph (1) of this subsection
46	shall be on a form provided by the Chief that can be submitted online via the Metropolitan
47	Police Department website, by mail, or in person.
48	"(d)(1) The Metropolitan Police Department shall mail a renewal notice to each
49	registrant at least 90 days prior to the expiration of the registration certificate.
50	"(2) A renewal application shall be received by the Metropolitan Police
51	Department at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the current registration certificate to
52	ensure timely renewal.
53	"(3) It is the duty of the registrant to timely renew a registration before its
54	expiration date and a failure of the Metropolitan Police Department to mail or the
55	registrant to receive the notice required under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall not
56	prevent a registration from expiring as of that date.".
57	Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

62	This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
63	the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional
