 11 Section 1. Paragraph (n) of subsection (2) of section
 12 790.06, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (o), a
 13 new paragraph (n) is added to that subsection, and paragraph (m)
 14 of that subsection is amended to read:

15 790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.—

16 (2) The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services
 17 shall issue a license if the applicant:

18 (m) Has not been issued an injunction that is currently in
 19 force and effect and that restrains the applicant from
 20 committing acts of domestic violence or acts of repeat violence;

22 (n) Has undergone a mental health evaluation conducted by
 23 a clinical psychologist or a psychiatrist, as those terms are
 24 defined in s. 394.455, and has been determined to be competent
 25 and of sound mind or provides a letter from a medical

27 | that the professional has examined the individual and the
28 | individual is not suffering from any serious mental illness; and
