AN ACT concerning crimes, punishment and criminal procedure; relating to firearms; creating the crime of unlawful abandonment of a firearm.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Unlawful abandonment of a firearm is abandoning or otherwise leaving a firearm in a public place where such firearm may be accessible to a person other than the owner of such firearm, with no requirement of a culpable mental state.

- (b) Unlawful abandonment of a firearm is a:
- (1) Class C misdemeanor; or
- (2) severity level 10, nonperson felony, if the unlawful conduct results in the bodily harm or death of a person.
 - (c) As used in this section:
- (1) "Abandoning or otherwise leaving" means to place a firearm such that the person no longer has immediate access or control over such firearm.
- (2) "Public place" means any area open to or used by the general public. A private residence shall not be considered a public place unless such residence is used for business purposes and is open to the general public.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
