1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to apportioned fleet
2 registration; mileage applications, fees and calculations; amending
3 K.S.A. 8-1,107 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 8-1,107 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-
7 1,107. ~~(a)~~—The initial application for apportioned registration of a fleet
8 shall state the in-state miles and total fleet miles with respect to such fleet
9 for the preceding year in this and other jurisdictions. ~~If no operations were~~
10 ~~conducted with such fleet during the preceding year, the application shall~~
11 ~~contain a full statement of the proposed method of operation and estimates~~
12 ~~of annual in-state and total fleet mileage. The director may evaluate and~~
13 ~~adjust the estimate in the application if the director is not satisfied as to the~~
14 ~~correctness thereof. The director shall not accept estimated mileage~~
15 ~~beyond the initial application and registration year for which apportioned~~
16 ~~fleet registration is sought.~~

17 (b) ~~If an owner desires to apportion the registration of a fleet with a~~
18 ~~jurisdiction after an initial application has been filed or for a subsequent~~
19 ~~registration year after the initial registration year, and such owner did not~~
20 ~~conduct operations in such jurisdiction during the preceding year, such~~
21 ~~owner may apportion the registration of a fleet in such jurisdiction by~~
22 ~~filing an affidavit with the division of vehicles upon a form provided by~~
23 ~~the division, which form shall provide a full statement of the proposed~~
24 ~~method of operation and an estimate of mileage in such jurisdiction. The~~
25 ~~division of vehicles shall compute the apportioned registration fee for such~~
26 ~~estimated mileage jurisdiction as follows: (1) Add the estimated mileage to~~
27 ~~the total fleet mileage reported or adjusted by audit for a registration year;~~
28 ~~(2) divide the estimated in-state miles for the jurisdiction by the adjusted~~
29 ~~total fleet mileage as determined under paragraph (1); (3) determine the~~
30 ~~total amount of fees necessary under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and~~
31 ~~amendments thereto, to register each and every vehicle of a fleet for which~~
32 ~~apportioned registration is sought, based on the regular annual fees for the~~
33 ~~unexpired portion of a registration year; (4) multiply the sum obtained~~
34 ~~under paragraph (3) by the percentage factor obtained under paragraph (2).~~
35 *Mileage applications and fees shall be charged according to the*
36 *international registration plan. All mileage calculations shall comply with*

1 *the rules of the international registration plan.*

2 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-1,107 is hereby repealed.

3 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

4 publication in the statute book.
