1 AN ACT concerning certain claims against the state, making  
2 appropriations, authorizing certain transfers, imposing certain  
3 restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain  
4 disbursements, procedures and acts incidental to the foregoing.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, appropriations are  
8 hereby made, restrictions and limitations are hereby imposed, and  
9 transfers, disbursements, procedures and acts incidental to the foregoing  
10 are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

32 Sec. 5. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this act, the director of  
 33 accounts and reports is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants on  
 34 the state treasurer in favor of the claimants specified in this act, upon  
 35 vouchers duly executed by the state agencies directed to pay the amounts  
 36 specified in such sections to the claimants or their legal representatives or  
 37 duly authorized agents, as provided by law.

38 (b) The director of accounts and reports shall secure prior to the  
 39 payment of any amount to any claimant, other than amounts authorized to  
 40 be paid pursuant to section 4, and amendments thereto, as motor-vehicle  
 41 fuel tax refunds or as transactions between state agencies as provided by  
 42 this act, a written release and satisfaction of all claims and rights against  
 43 the state of Kansas and any agencies, officers and employees of the state of

1 Kansas regarding their respective claims.

2 Sec. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
3 publication in the Kansas register.
