## Handgun Permits – Alternative Expiration Date – Private Detectives, Security Guards, and Special Police Officers

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of State Police to establish an alternative expiration date for a permit to carry, wear, or transport a handgun that coincides with the expiration of a certain license or commission that the holder has been issued; and generally relating to handgun permits.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Public Safety
- 21 5-309.

- 1 (a) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, A permit 2 expires on the last day of the holder's birth month following 2 years after the date the 3 permit is issued.
- 4 (D) THE SECRETARY MAY ESTABLISH AN ALTERNATIVE EXPIRATION DATE 5 FOR A PERMIT TO COINCIDE WITH THE EXPIRATION OF A LICENSE OR COMMISSION 6 FOR:
- 7 (1) A PRIVATE DETECTIVE UNDER TITLE 13 OF THE BUSINESS 8 OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE;
- 9 (2) A SECURITY GUARD UNDER TITLE 19 OF THE BUSINESS 10 OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE; OR
- 11 (3) A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER UNDER § 3–306 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2017.
