- 16 Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a
- person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal 17 may not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards, 18

- known as the "safety zone", of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or 20 camp occupied by human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is
- 21within this area, without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
- 22A person, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal, may not 23 shoot or discharge any firearm within 300 yards of a public or nonpublic school during
- school hours or at a time when a school-approved activity is taking place. 24

1 2 3 4	(3) (i) For archery hunters in Carroll County or Frederick County, the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
5 6 7 8	(ii) For archery hunters in Harford County OR ST. MARY'S COUNTY , the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 100 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
9 10 11	(4) During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
12 13	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014 .
