A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Archery Hunting – Safety Zone**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing for archery hunters a safety zone of a certain size
4 within which archery hunting may not take place except under certain
5 circumstances; and generally relating to archery hunting.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Natural Resources**

14 10–410.

15 (g) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a
16 person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal
17 may not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards,
18 known as the “safety zone”, of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or
19 camp occupied by human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is
20 within this area, without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

21 (2) A person, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal, may not
22 shoot or discharge any firearm within 300 yards of a public or nonpublic school during
23 school hours or at a time when a school–approved activity is taking place.

1 (3) [(i)] For archery hunters [in Carroll County or Frederick
2 County], the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50
3 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied
4 by human beings.

5 (ii) For archery hunters in Harford County, the safety zone
6 described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 100 yards from a dwelling
7 house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.]

8 (4) During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or
9 occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety
10 zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 July 1, 2014.
