## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Handgun Permits – Reciprocity**

3 FOR the purpose of specifying that a permit issued by another state to an individual to  
4 carry a handgun, including a concealed handgun, is valid in Maryland; and generally  
5 relating to handgun permits.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
7 Article – Public Safety  
8 Section 5–303  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2011 Replacement Volume and 2014 Supplement)

11 BY adding to  
12 Article – Public Safety  
13 Section 5–303.1

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Public Safety**

1 A person shall have a permit issued under this subtitle before the person carries,  
2 wears, or transports a handgun.

3 **5-303.1.**

4 **A PERMIT ISSUED BY ANOTHER STATE TO AN INDIVIDUAL TO CARRY A**  
5 **HANDGUN, INCLUDING A CONCEALED HANDGUN, IS VALID IN THIS STATE.**

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 October 1, 2015.
