2 **Department of State Police – Handgun Roster Board – Definition of Handgun**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of handgun for purposes of provisions relating
4 to the Handgun Roster Board to exclude certain firearms from the definition; and
5 generally relating to the Handgun Roster Board.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Public Safety**

14 5–401.

15 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

16 (b) “Board” means the Handgun Roster Board.

1 (c) (1) "Handgun" [has the meaning stated in § 4-201 of the Criminal Law
2 Article] MEANS A PISTOL, A REVOLVER, OR ANY OTHER FIREARM CAPABLE OF BEING
3 CONCEALED ON THE PERSON.

4 (2) "HANDGUN" DOES NOT INCLUDE A SHOTGUN, A RIFLE,
5 A SHORT-BARRELED RIFLE, A SHORT-BARRELED SHOTGUN, OR AN ANTIQUE
6 FIREARM.

7 (d) "Handgun roster" means the roster of authorized handguns compiled by the
8 Board under § 5-405 of this subtitle.

9 (e) "Secretary" means the Secretary of State Police or the Secretary's designee.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2015.
