A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Handgun Permits – Term**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of State Police to set the date for expiration
4 of a handgun permit under certain circumstances; clarifying that an expiration date
5 for a handgun permit does not apply if the permit is renewed under certain
6 circumstances; and generally relating to handgun permits.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Public Safety**

15 5–309.

16 (a) **[A] UNLESS A PERMIT IS RENEWED FOR A 3–YEAR PERIOD AS PROVIDED**
17 **IN THIS SECTION, A permit expires on:**

18 **(1) the last day of the holder’s birth month following 2 years after the date**
19 **the permit is issued; OR**

20 **(2) THE DATE SET BY THE SECRETARY.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (b) A permit may be renewed for successive periods of 3 years each if, at the time
2 of an application for renewal, the applicant possesses the qualifications for the issuance of
3 a permit and pays the renewal fee stated in this subtitle.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2015.
