A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Handgun Permits – Universal Recognition**

3 FOR the purpose of specifying that a permit issued in certain other jurisdictions to an
4 individual to carry a handgun is valid in Maryland; and generally relating to
5 handgun permits.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Public Safety**

19 **5–303.**

20 A person shall have a permit issued under this subtitle before the person carries,
21 wears, or transports a handgun.

2 **A PERMIT ISSUED IN DELAWARE, PENNSYLVANIA, VIRGINIA, WASHINGTON,**
3 **D.C., OR WEST VIRGINIA TO AN INDIVIDUAL TO CARRY A HANDGUN IS VALID IN THIS**
4 **STATE.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
6 1, 2017.
