

- 16 (b) A firearm application shall contain:
- 17 (1) the firearm applicant's name, address, Social Security number, place 18 and date of birth, height, weight, race, eye and hair color, signature, driver's or 19
- photographic identification soundex number, occupation, and regulated firearm
- 20 information for each regulated firearm to be purchased, rented, or transferred;
- 21 the date and time that the firearm applicant delivered the completed 22 firearm application to the prospective seller or transferor;

- 1 (xiv) if under the age of 30 years at the time of application, has not 2 been adjudicated delinquent by a juvenile court for an act that would be a disqualifying 3 crime if committed by an adult; and
- 4 (4) [a copy of] UNLESS THE APPLICANT IS EXCLUDED UNDER § 5—117.1(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE, the applicant's handgun qualification license NUMBER.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2017.
