- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of State Police to issue a handgun permit to a person who is otherwise qualified, has the consent of a certain church or religious 4 5 organization to carry a handgun on the property of the church or religious 6 organization during certain events, and has the intent to wear, carry, or transport a 7 handgun for certain purposes on the property of the church or religious organization; 8 specifying that a handgun permit for a certain person shall authorize the person to 9 carry a handgun on the property of a church or religious organization during certain events and transport a handgun to and from certain church or religious organization 10 11 events; and generally relating to the issuing of permits to carry, wear, or transport 12 a handgun.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 9 (b) [The] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE Secretary may 10 limit the geographic area, circumstances, or times of the day, week, month, or year in which 11 a permit is effective.
- 12 (C) A PERSON WHO QUALIFIES BASED ON THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE
 13 GOVERNING BOARD OF A BONA FIDE CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION WITH
 14 THE INTENT TO WEAR, CARRY, OR TRANSPORT A HANDGUN ON THE PROPERTY OF
- 15 THE CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION UNDER § 5–306(A)(6)(II)2 OF THIS
- 16 SUBTITLE SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO:
- 17 (1) CARRY A HANDGUN ON THE PROPERTY OF THE CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION DURING SERVICES AND GATHERINGS; AND
- 19 **(2)** TRANSPORT A HANDGUN TO AND FROM SERVICES AND 20 GATHERINGS OF THE CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
