Final Protective Orders - Relief - Transfer of Wireless Telephone Service

FOR the purpose of authorizing the court, in a temporary protective order or a final protective order, to order a wireless telephone service provider to transfer to a person eligible for relief the billing responsibility for and the right to continue the use of a certain telephone number under certain circumstances; requiring the court to serve a certain order on a wireless telephone service provider's resident agent; requiring a wireless telephone service provider to comply with a certain order within a certain time frame unless the wireless telephone service provider provides certain notice requiring a wireless telephone service provider to comply with a certain order unless the wireless telephone service provider cannot operationally or technically effectuate the order; requiring a certain order to include certain information; providing that a certain order terminates the respondent's financial responsibility for and use of a certain telephone number; prohibiting a wireless telephone service provider from charging a person eligible for relief a certain fee; establishing that a wireless telephone service provider's standard requirements for establishing an account and transferring a telephone number apply to a transfer required under this Act; providing that a wireless telephone service provider is immune from civil liability for complying with a certain order; requiring the court to ensure that certain information is not disclosed to an account holder in certain proceedings; and generally relating to protective orders and wireless telephone service.
