- 4 (D) A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A CIVIL OFFENSE PUNISHABLE BY A 5 FINE NOT EXCEEDING:
- 6 (1) \$500 FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE; AND
- 7 (2) \$1,500 FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2020.
