- FOR the purpose of altering the purpose of the Maryland State Police Gun Center to include the tracking, screening, and vetting of all firearms surrendered under final protective orders in the State; requiring each law enforcement agency to report to the Center certain information on certain firearms surrendered under final protective orders; and generally relating to the Maryland State Police Gun Center.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 5-801.
- 18 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

- 1 (b) "Center" means the Maryland State Police Gun Center.
- 2 (c) "Crime firearm" means a firearm that is:
- 3 (1) used in the commission of a crime of violence, as defined in $\S 5-101$ of 4 this title; or
- 5 (2) recovered by a law enforcement agency in connection with illegal 6 firearm possession, transportation, or transfer.
- 7 (d) "Department" means the Department of State Police.
- 8 (e) "Federally licensed firearms dealer" means a person licensed by the federal 9 Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives to deal in firearms.
- 10 (f) "Federally licensed firearms importer" means a person licensed by the federal 11 Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives to import firearms.
- 12 (G) "FINAL PROTECTIVE ORDER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 4–501 OF 13 THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.
- 14 **[(g)] (H)** "Law enforcement agency" has the meaning stated in § 3–201 of this 15 article.

- 17 (a) The Center is established within the Department as a statewide firearms enforcement center for the tracking, screening, and vetting of all:
- 19 (1) firearm crimes committed in the State; AND
- 20 (2) FIREARMS SURRENDERED UNDER FINAL PROTECTIVE ORDERS IN 21 THE STATE.
- 22 (b) This subtitle shall be liberally construed and applied to promote its underlying 23 purposes and policies.

- 25 (a) The Center shall create and maintain a statewide database to track 26 information on crimes committed with crime firearms AND FIREARMS SURRENDERED 27 UNDER FINAL PROTECTIVE ORDERS IN THE STATE.
