BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments. - 5 (l) "Licensed firearms dealer" means a person who holds a dealer's license under 6 Title 5, Subtitle 1 of the Public Safety Article.
- 7 (m) (1) "Rapid fire trigger activator" means any device, including a removable 8 manual or power-driven activating device, constructed so that, when installed in or 9 attached to a firearm:
- 10 (i) the rate at which the trigger is activated increases; or
- 11 (ii) the rate of fire increases.
- 12 (2) "Rapid fire trigger activator" includes a bump stock, trigger crank, 13 hellfire trigger, binary trigger system, burst trigger system, <u>SWITCH/AUTO-SEAR</u>, or a 14 copy or a similar device, regardless of the producer or manufacturer.
- 15 (3) "Rapid fire trigger activator" does not include a semiautomatic replacement trigger that improves the performance and functionality over the stock trigger.

 18 INTENDED FOR USE IN CONVERTING A FIREARM INTO A WEAPON THAT SHOOTS, IS
 19 DESIGNED TO SHOOT, OR CAN BE READILY RESTORED TO SHOOT AUTOMATICALLY
 20 MORE THAN ONE SHOT, WITHOUT MANUAL RELOADING, BY A SINGLE FUNCTION OF
 21 THE TRIGGER APPLIES FORCE TO A FIREARM'S TRIGGER BAR TO PREVENT IT FROM
