- 16 (A-3) (1) (I) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2024, AND EACH OCTOBER 1
- 17 THEREAFTER, THE SECRETARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE
- 18 ATTORNEY GENERAL, SHALL PUBLISH A HANDBOOK SUMMARIZING THE STATE
- 19 LAWS THAT APPLY TO THE WEARING, CARRYING, AND TRANSPORTING OF A
- 20 HANDGUN IN PUBLIC IN THE STATE.
