AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 947  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Woods**” and substitute “**Woods, Conaway, and Moon**”; line 10, strike “or certain persons” and substitute “, a county attorney, or the Baltimore City Solicitor”; and in line 11, after the semicolon insert “requiring that the Attorney General study the legality and feasibility of a certain statutory requirement”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 8 through 10, inclusive; strike beginning with the semicolon in line 19 down through “**STATE**” in line 21; in line 17, after the semicolon insert “**OR**”; and in lines 11, 14, 22, and 26, strike “**(D)**”, “**(E)**”, “**(F)**”, and “**(G)**”, respectively, and substitute “**(C)**”, “**(D)**”, “**(E)**”, and “**(F)**”, respectively.

On page 3, in line 16, strike “**(H)**” and substitute “**(G)**”.

On page 4, in line 3, after “**GENERAL**” insert “**, A COUNTY ATTORNEY, OR THE BALTIMORE CITY SOLICITOR**”; and in line 7, after “**GENERAL**” insert “**, COUNTY ATTORNEY, OR BALTIMORE CITY SOLICITOR**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 4 and 5, strike beginning with “**(B)**” in line 13 on page 4 down through the period in line 2 on page 5.

On page 5, in line 3, strike “**(C)**” and substitute “**(B)**”; after line 15, insert:

“**SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:**

(a) The Attorney General, in consultation with the Department of State Police, shall study and make recommendations regarding the legality and feasibility of a statutory requirement that would compel licensed firearm dealers within the State to provide records of firearm trace requests received from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives to the Attorney General.

(b) The Attorney General shall provide staff for the study.

(c) On or before June 30, 2025, the Attorney General shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, on its recommendations and findings.”;

and in line 16, strike “3.” and substitute “4.”.
