An Act relative to senior gun owner equity.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 129B of chapter 140, as most recently amended by section 93 of  
2 chapter 68, is hereby further amended by inserting at the end of clause (10) the following:-

3           Notwithstanding the first sentence of clause (9A), the renewal fee for a firearm  
4 identification card for any person over the age of 64 shall be prorated and calculated by dividing  
5 the fee required for renewal under clause (9A) by 6 and multiplying that product by the number  
6 of years until the applicant becomes exempt from paying a renewal fee under this clause.
