1.8	An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the amendment
1.9	is adopted, a section shall be added to article I, to read:
1.10	Sec. 18. The right of individuals to acquire, keep, possess, transport, carry, transfer,
1.11	and use arms including firearms, knives, or any other weapons and ammunition, components,
1.12	and accessories for the arms is fundamental and shall not be denied, infringed, or curtailed.
1.13	Any restriction must be subjected to strict scrutiny review. Registration, mandatory licensing,
1.14	special taxation, fees, or any other measure, regardless of type, manner, or purpose, that
1.15	suppresses or discourages the free exercise of the right is forbidden.
