A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION FROM LIABILITY FOR EMPLOYERS FOR THE MISUSE OF A FIREARM TAKEN FROM A PRIVATE VEHICLE AT THE EMPLOYER'S WORKPLACE IF THE EMPLOYER DOES NOT HAVE A POLICY PROHIBITING FIREARMS FROM BEING SECURED IN VEHICLES AT THE WORKPLACE IF THE EMPLOYER DOES NOT HAVE A POLICY PROHIBITING FIREARMS FROM BEING SECURED IN VEHICLES AT THE WORKPLACE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Immunity for employer for misuse of firearm. A private sector employer THAT DOES NOT HAVE OR ENFORCE A POLICY PROHIBITING EMPLOYEES FROM KEEPING A FIREARM OUT OF SIGHT AND LOCKED IN AN EMPLOYEE'S VEHICLE AT THE EMPLOYER'S WORKPLACE ~~that does not have or enforce a policy prohibiting employees from keeping a firearm out of sight and locked in an employee's vehicle at the employer's workplace~~ may not be held liable for any incident, injury, or damages resulting from a firearm being taken from an employee's motor vehicle parked at the employee's workplace."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 27, chapter 1, part 7, and the provisions of Title 27, chapter 1, part 7, apply to [section 1].
