- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Concealed Handgun Permit Act; to amend section 69-2429, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 69-2427, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to define a term; to provide signage requirements and duties for the Nebraska
- 5 State Patrol; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
- 6 sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 69-2427, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2014, is amended to read:
- 3 69-2427 Sections 69-2427 to 69-2449 and section 3 of this act shall
- 4 be known and may be cited as the Concealed Handgun Permit Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 69-2429, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 69-2429 For purposes of the Concealed Handgun Permit Act:
- 8 (1) Concealed handgun means the handgun is totally hidden from view.
- 9 If any part of the handgun is capable of being seen, it is not a
- 10 concealed handgun;
- 11 (2) Emergency services personnel means a volunteer or paid
- 12 firefighter or rescue squad member or a person licensed to provide
- 13 emergency medical services pursuant to the Emergency Medical Services
- 14 Practice Act;
- 15 (3) Handgun means any firearm with a barrel less than sixteen inches
- in length or any firearm designed to be held and fired by the use of a
- 17 single hand;
- 18 (4) Peace officer means any town marshal, chief of police or local
- 19 police officer, sheriff or deputy sheriff, the Superintendent of Law
- 20 Enforcement and Public Safety, any officer of the Nebraska State Patrol,
- 21 any member of the National Guard on active service by direction of the
- 22 Governor during periods of emergency or civil disorder, any Game and
- 23 Parks Commission conservation officer, and all other persons with similar
- 24 authority to make arrests;
- 25 (5) Permitholder means an individual holding a current and valid
- 26 permit to carry a concealed handgun issued pursuant to the Concealed
- 27 Handgun Permit Act;—and
- 28 (6) Posted conspicuous notice means a clearly visible sign posted at
- 29 <u>each entrance to a place or premises open to the public. The sign shall</u>
- 30 comply with section 3 of this act; and
- 31 (7 6) Proof of training means an original document or certified copy

1 of a document, supplied by an applicant, that certifies that he or she

- 2 either:
- 3 (a) Within the previous three years, has successfully completed a
- 4 handgun training and safety course approved by the Nebraska State Patrol
- 5 pursuant to section 69-2432; or
- 6 (b) Is a member of the active or reserve armed forces of the United
- 7 States or a member of the National Guard and has had handgun training
- 8 within the previous three years which meets the minimum safety and
- 9 training requirements of section 69-2432.
- 10 Sec. 3. (1) The Nebraska State Patrol shall design a standardized
- 11 sign for use by any person, entity, or employer in control of property
- 12 prohibiting a permitholder from carrying a concealed handgun in or on the
- 13 place or premises.
- 14 <u>(2) The sign:</u>
- 15 (a) Shall be at least five inches tall and three and one-half inches
- 16 wide;
- 17 <u>(b) Shall have a white background containing a two inch red circle</u>
- 18 with a slash covering an image of a black handgun;
- 19 (c) Shall use contrasting black and red font and include the
- 20 <u>following text: NOTICE. Carrying a concealed handgun by a permitholder is</u>
- 21 PROHIBITED in or on this place or premises by the controllers of this
- 22 property. Posted pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statutes section 69-2441;
- 23 (d) Shall be posted at each entrance to the place or premises
- 24 between forty-eight inches and sixty-six inches above the floor or
- 25 ground;
- 26 <u>(e) Shall, if the place or premises is a building, be posted (i)</u>
- 27 either on the door of each entrance to the place or premises or within
- 28 twelve inches on either side of the doorway of each entrance or (ii) on
- 29 every door or within twelve inches on both sides of every doorway with
- 30 double doors along the width of the entrance, if the entrance has
- 31 multiple doorways;

- 1 (f) Shall, if the place or premises is not a building, be posted
- 2 <u>within twenty-four inches on either side of each designated motor</u>
- 3 vehicle, bicycle, or pedestrian entrance to the place or premises; and
- 4 (g) Shall not be obstructed or altered in any way and, if the sign
- 5 becomes illegible for any reason, be immediately replaced with a legible
- 6 sign.
