Referred to: Judiciary 2, if favorable, Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House February 7, 2023 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT LEAVING A FIREARM IN AN UNATTENDED MOTOR VEHICLE UNLESS THE VEHICLE IS LOCKED AND THE FIREARM IS SECURED OR OTHERWISE SAFELY STORED. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 35 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-269.9. Firearms in unattended motor vehicles. Definition. – For purposes of this section, the term "firearm" is as defined in (a) G.S. 14-408.1. (b) <u>Prohibition.</u> – It is unlawful to leave a firearm in an unattended motor vehicle unless the vehicle is locked and the firearm is either (i) secured with a trigger lock or other safety device designed to prevent an unauthorized user from operating the firearm or (ii) in a locked container. Penalty. – Any person who violates subsection (b) of this section is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2023, and applies to offenses
