7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making  
8 certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; providing  
for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1740.2 of Title 21, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Every person who buys or receives, in any manner, upon any  
16 consideration, any firearm of any value whatsoever that has been  
17 stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or  
18 having reasonable cause to believe the same to have been stolen,  
19 embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery shall, upon  
20 conviction, be guilty of grand larceny punishable by imprisonment in  
21 the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to  
22 exceed five (5) years or a fine of not more than Five Thousand  
23 Dollars (\$5,000.00) or by both such fine and imprisonment.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
