AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 2 articles, further providing for Pennsylvania State Police and 3 for licensing of dealers. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 6111.1(b)(1) of Title 18 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 9 § 6111.1. Pennsylvania State Police. * * * 10 (b) Duty of Pennsylvania State Police. --11 12 (1)Upon receipt of a request for a criminal history, juvenile delinquency history and mental health record check 13 14 of the potential purchaser [or], transferee[,] or dealer or 15 employee of a dealer, the Pennsylvania State Police shall immediately during the licensee's call or by return call 16 17 forthwith:

(i) review the Pennsylvania State Police criminal

- 2 potential purchaser or transferee is prohibited from
- 3 receipt or possession of a firearm under Federal or State
- 4 law;
- 5 (ii) review the juvenile delinquency and mental
- 6 health records of the Pennsylvania State Police to
- determine whether the potential purchaser or transferee
- 8 is prohibited from receipt or possession of a firearm
- 9 under Federal or State law; and
- 10 (iii) inform the licensee making the inquiry either:
- 11 (A) that the potential purchase or transfer is
- 12 prohibited; or
- 13 (B) provide the licensee with a unique approval
- 14 number.

- Section 2. Section 6113(a) of Title 18 is amended by adding
- 17 a paragraph to read:
- 18 § 6113. Licensing of dealers.
- 19 (a) General rule. -- The chief or head of any police force or
- 20 police department of a city, and, elsewhere, the sheriff of the
- 21 county, shall grant to reputable applicants licenses, in form
- 22 prescribed by the Pennsylvania State Police, effective for three
- 23 years from date of issue, permitting the licensee to sell
- 24 firearms direct to the consumer, subject to the following
- 25 conditions in addition to those specified in section 6111
- 26 (relating to sale or transfer of firearms), for breach of any of
- 27 which the license shall be forfeited and the licensee subject to
- 28 punishment as provided in this subchapter:

- 30 (8) The dealer and an employee of a dealer who engage in

- 2 provided under this chapter.

- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
