AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 2 articles, further providing for firearms not to be carried 3 without a license, for the offense of possession of firearm by minor and for loans on, or lending or giving firearms 5 prohibited. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Sections 6106(c), 6110.1 and 6115(b)(1)(iv)(A) of 10 Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 11 12 § 6106. Firearms not to be carried without a license. 13 14 (c) Sportsman's firearm permit. --15 (1)Before any exception shall be granted under 16 paragraph (b) (9) or (10) of this section to any person [18] 17 21 years of age or older licensed to hunt, trap or fish or 18 who has been issued a permit relating to hunting dogs, such person shall, at the time of securing his hunting, furtaking 19

- or fishing license or any time after such license has been
- issued, secure a sportsman's firearm permit from the county
- 3 treasurer. The sportsman's firearm permit shall be issued
- 4 immediately and be valid throughout this Commonwealth for a
- 5 period of five years from the date of issue for any legal
- firearm, when carried in conjunction with a valid hunting,
- 7 furtaking or fishing license or permit relating to hunting
- 8 dogs. The sportsman's firearm permit shall be in triplicate
- 9 on a form to be furnished by the Pennsylvania State Police.
- 10 The original permit shall be delivered to the person, and the
- first copy thereof, within seven days, shall be forwarded to
- the Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police by the
- county treasurer. The second copy shall be retained by the
- 14 county treasurer for a period of two years from the date of
- expiration. The county treasurer shall be entitled to collect
- a fee of not more than \$6 for each such permit issued, which
- shall include the cost of any official form. The Pennsylvania
- 18 State Police may recover from the county treasurer the cost
- of any such form, but may not charge more than \$1 for each
- official permit form furnished to the county treasurer.
- 21 (2) Any person who sells or attempts to sell a
- sportsman's firearm permit for a fee in excess of that amount
- fixed under this subsection commits a summary offense.

- 25 § 6110.1. Possession of firearm by minor.
- 26 (a) Firearm.--Except as provided in subsection (b), a person
- 27 under [18] 21 years of age shall not possess or transport a
- 28 firearm anywhere in this Commonwealth.
- 29 (b) Exception. -- Subsection (a) shall not apply to a person
- 30 under [18] <u>21</u> years of age:

- 1 (1) who is under the supervision of a parent,
- 2 grandparent, legal guardian or an adult acting with the
- 3 expressed consent of the minor's custodial parent or legal
- 4 guardian and the minor is engaged in lawful activity,
- 5 including safety training, lawful target shooting, engaging
- 6 in an organized competition involving the use of a firearm or
- 7 the firearm is unloaded and the minor is transporting it for
- 8 a lawful purpose; [or]
- 9 (2) who is lawfully hunting or trapping in accordance
- 10 with 34 Pa.C.S. (relating to game)[.]; or
- 11 (3) who owned a firearm prior to January 1, 2023.
- 12 (c) Responsibility of adult. -- Any person who knowingly and
- 13 intentionally delivers or provides to the minor a firearm in
- 14 violation of subsection (a) commits a felony of the third
- 15 degree.
- 16 (d) Forfeiture. -- Any firearm in the possession of a person
- 17 under [18] 21 years of age in violation of this section shall be
- 18 promptly seized by the arresting law enforcement officer and
- 19 upon conviction or adjudication of delinquency shall be
- 20 forfeited or, if stolen, returned to the lawful owner.

- 24 (1) Subsection (a) shall not apply if any of the

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2023.
