AN ACT

- Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in other subjects of taxation, further
- providing for excise tax on hotel room rental.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 8721(h) of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 8721. Hotel room rental.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (h) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 11 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 12 subsection:
- "Consideration." Receipts, fees, charges, rentals, leases,
- 14 cash, credits, property, any amount charged by an intermediary
- 15 to an occupant and retained by the intermediary, or other
- 16 payment received by operators in exchange for or in
- 17 consideration of the use or occupancy by a transient of a room
- 18 in a hotel for a temporary period.

- 1 "Convention center or exhibition hall." A building or series
- 2 of buildings:
- 3 (1) at least one of which contains a minimum of 75,000
- 4 gross square feet of exhibition space for shows and
- 5 conventions;
- 6 (2) which are not used for the retail sale of
- 7 merchandise or part of any shopping center, mall or other
- 8 retail center;
- 9 (3) a major function of which is to house meetings,
- exhibitions, shows, conventions, assemblies, convocations and
- similar gatherings. The term includes land appurtenant to the
- 12 building or buildings.
- "Cooperating political subdivision or agency of government."
- 14 A city or public authority located in a county:
- 15 (1) within the boundaries of which a convention center
- or exhibition hall is planned or constructed; and
- 17 (2) which shares with the county duties, obligations or
- 18 privileges with respect to that convention center.
- 19 "Hotel." Any of the following:
- 20 (1) Any hotel, motel, inn, guest house or other building
- 21 located within the taxing jurisdiction which holds itself out
- by any means, including advertising, license, registration
- with any innkeeper's group, convention listing association,
- travel publication or similar association or with any
- 25 government agency, as being available to provide overnight
- lodging or use of facility space for consideration to persons
- 27 seeking temporary accommodation.
- 28 (2) A place which advertises to the public at large or a
- segment of the public at large that it will provide beds,
- 30 sanitary facilities or other space for a temporary period to

- 1 members of the public at large.
- 2 (3) A place recognized as a hostelry.
- 3 The term does not include portions of the facility which are
- 4 devoted to individuals who have established permanent residence.
- 5 "Intermediary." A person who facilitates the booking of
- 6 <u>hotel reservations and who is not an operator.</u>
- 7 "Municipality." Notwithstanding section 8401 (relating to
- 8 definitions), a township or borough or a home rule municipality
- 9 which was formerly a township or borough.
- 10 "Occupancy." The use or possession or the right to the use
- 11 or possession by any person other than a permanent resident of a
- 12 room in a hotel for any purpose or the right to the use or
- 13 possession of the furnishings or to the services accompanying
- 14 the use and possession of the room.
- "Operating deficit." The excess of expenses over receipts
- 16 from the operation and management of a convention center or
- 17 exhibition hall.
- 18 "Operator." Any individual, partnership, nonprofit or
- 19 profit-making association or corporation or other person or
- 20 group of persons that maintain, operate, manage, own, have
- 21 custody of or otherwise possess the right to rent or lease
- 22 overnight accommodations in a hotel to the public for
- 23 consideration.
- 24 "Patron." A person that pays the consideration for the
- 25 occupancy of a room in a hotel.
- 26 "Permanent resident." An individual who has occupied or has
- 27 the right to occupancy of a room in a hotel as a patron or
- 28 otherwise for a period exceeding 30 consecutive days.
- 29 "Recognized tourist promotion agency." As defined in section
- 30 3(6) of the former act of April 28, 1961 (P.L.111, No.50), known

- 1 as the Tourist Promotion Law and in accordance with the Tourist
- 2 Promotion Law, the nonprofit corporation, organization,
- 3 association or agency:
- 4 (1) which is and has been engaged in planning and
- 5 promoting programs designed to stimulate and increase the
- 6 volume of tourist, visitor and vacation business within
- 7 counties it serves; and
- 8 (2) which is recognized by the Department of Community
- 9 and Economic Development.
- 10 "Regional tourist promotion activities." Services,
- 11 activities, facilities and events, which result in a significant
- 12 number of nonresidents visiting a county of the second class for
- 13 recreational, cultural or educational purposes.
- 14 "Room." A space in a hotel set aside for use and occupancy
- 15 by patrons, or otherwise, for consideration, having at least one
- 16 bed or other sleeping accommodation.
- 17 "Substantial completion." Construction which is sufficiently
- 18 completed in accordance with contract documents and certified by
- 19 the convention center authority's architect or engineer, as
- 20 modified by change orders so that:
- 21 (1) the main convention area can be used, occupied or
- 22 operated for its intended use; and
- 23 (2) at least 90% of the work on the main convention or
- 24 exhibition area is complete.
- 25 "Temporary." A period of time not exceeding 30 consecutive
- 26 days.
- 27 "Transaction." The activity involving the obtaining by a
- 28 transient or patron of the use or occupancy of a hotel room from
- 29 which consideration emanates to the operator under an express or
- 30 an implied contract.

- 1 "Transient." An individual who obtains accommodation in any
- 2 hotel for himself by means of registering at the facility for
- 3 the temporary occupancy of any room for the personal use of that
- 4 individual by paying to the operator of the facility a fee in
- 5 consideration for the accommodation.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
