## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
- articles, further providing for definitions and for
- 4 possession of firearm by minor.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 6102 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding definitions to read:
- 9 § 6102. Definitions.
- 10 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 11 provisions of this subchapter which are applicable to specific
- 12 provisions of this subchapter, the following words and phrases,
- 13 when used in this subchapter shall have, unless the context
- 14 clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this
- 15 section:
- 16 "Assault weapon." Any of the following:
- 17 (1) A semiautomatic rifle that has an ability to accept

2	following characteristics:
3	(i) A part or combination of parts designed and
4	intended to accelerate the rate of fire of the
5	semiautomatic firearm to simulate the rate of fire of a
6	machinegun.
7	(ii) A folding or telescoping stock.
8	(iii) A pistol grip that protrudes conspicuously
9	beneath the action of the semiautomatic rifle.
10	(iv) A thumbhole stock, a second handgrip or a
11	protruding grip that can be held by the nontrigger hand.
12	(v) A bayonet mount, a flash suppressor, muzzle
13	break or muzzle compensator.
14	(vi) A threaded barrel designed to accommodate a
15	flash suppressor, muzzle break or muzzle compensator.
16	(vii) A grenade launcher.
17	(2) A semiautomatic shotgun that has at least one of the
18	<pre>following characteristics:</pre>
19	(i) A folding or telescoping stock.
20	(ii) A thumbhole stock.
21	(iii) A second handgrip or a protruding grip that
22	can be held by the nontrigger hand.
23	(iv) A fixed magazine capacity in excess of seven
24	rounds.
25	(v) An ability to accept a detachable magazine.
26	(vi) A revolving cylinder.

28	"Machinegun." As defined in section 201 of the Internal
29	Revenue Code of 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. § 5845).
30	"Peace officer." Any of the following:

- 1 (1) A person who by virtue of the person's office or
- 2 <u>public employment is vested by law with a duty to maintain</u>
- 3 public order or make arrests for criminal offenses, whether
- 4 <u>the duty extends to all criminal offenses or is limited to</u>
- 5 specific criminal offenses.
- 6 (2) A person on active State duty under 51 Pa.C.S. § 508
- 7 <u>(relating to active duty for emergency).</u>
- 8 (3) A member of a park police department of a county of
- 9 the third class.

- 11 <u>"Weapon-carrying officer." A county probation or parole</u>
- 12 officer who is authorized to carry a weapon in connection with
- 13 performance of the duties of the officer's employment.
- 14 Section 2. Section 6110.1 of Title 18 is amended to read:
- 15 § 6110.1. Possession of firearm or assault weapon by minor.
- 16 (a) Firearm. -- Except as provided in subsection (b), a person
- 17 under 18 years of age shall not possess or transport a firearm
- 18 anywhere in this Commonwealth.
- 19 (a.1) Assault weapon. -- Except as provided in subsection
- 20 (b.1), a person under 21 years of age shall not purchase,
- 21 possess or transport an assault weapon.
- 22 (b) [Exception] <u>Firearm exception</u>.--Subsection (a) shall not
- 23 apply to a person under 18 years of age:
- 24 (1) who is under the supervision of a parent,
- 25 grandparent, legal guardian or an adult acting with the
- 26 expressed consent of the minor's custodial parent or legal
- guardian and the minor is engaged in lawful activity,
- including safety training, lawful target shooting, engaging
- in an organized competition involving the use of a firearm or
- 30 the firearm is unloaded and the minor is transporting it for

- 1 a lawful purpose; or
- 2 (2) who is lawfully hunting or trapping in accordance
- 3 with 34 Pa.C.S. (relating to game).
- 4 (b.1) Assault weapon exception. -- Subsection (a.1) shall not
- 5 apply to a person under 21 years of age:
- 6 (1) who is a member of the armed services;
- 7 (2) who is an authorized weapon-carrying officer; or
- 8 <u>(3) who is a vested peace officer.</u>
- 9 (c) Responsibility of adult. -- Any person who knowingly and
- 10 intentionally delivers or provides to the minor a firearm in
- 11 violation of subsection (a), or to a person under 21 years of
- 12 age an assault weapon in violation of subsection (a.1), commits
- 13 a felony of the third degree.
- 14 (d) Forfeiture. -- Any firearm in the possession of a person
- 15 under 18 years of age or assault weapon in the possession of a
- 16 person under 21 years of age in violation of this section shall
- 17 be promptly seized by the arresting law enforcement officer and
- 18 upon conviction or adjudication of delinquency shall be
- 19 forfeited or, if stolen, returned to the lawful owner.
- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
