1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
3 articles, further providing for persons not to possess, use,
4 manufacture, control, sell or transfer firearms AND FOR SALE <--
5 OR TRANSFER OF FIREARMS.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 6105(d.1)(3) of Title 18 of the <--
9 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

10 SECTION 1. SECTIONS 6105(D.1) (3) AND 6111(D.1) (3) OF TITLE <--
11 18 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA CONSOLIDATED STATUTES ARE AMENDED TO
12 READ:

13 § 6105. Persons not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell
14 or transfer firearms.

16 (d.1) Concurrent jurisdiction to prosecute.--The following
17 apply in a city of the first class where the Attorney General
18 has operated a joint local-State firearm task force:

2 (3) This subsection shall not apply to any case
3 instituted [two years after the effective date of this
4 subsection.]:

5 (i) after September 2, 2021, and before the
6 effective date of this subparagraph; or

7 (ii) after December 31, 2025.

9 § 6111. SALE OR TRANSFER OF FIREARMS.

11 (D.1) CONCURRENT JURISDICTION TO PROSECUTE.--THE FOLLOWING
12 APPLY IN A CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS WHERE THE ATTORNEY GENERAL
13 HAS OPERATED A JOINT LOCAL-STATE FIREARM TASK FORCE:

15 (3) THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY CASE
16 INSTITUTED [TWO YEARS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
17 SUBSECTION.]:

18 (I) AFTER SEPTEMBER 2, 2021, AND BEFORE THE
19 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH; OR

20 (II) AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2025.
