## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
- articles, further providing for definitions and for sale or
- 4 transfer of firearms.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 6102 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding definitions to read:
- 9 § 6102. Definitions.
- 10 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 11 provisions of this subchapter which are applicable to specific
- 12 provisions of this subchapter, the following words and phrases,
- 13 when used in this subchapter shall have, unless the context
- 14 clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this
- 15 section:

- 17 <u>"Rifle." A weapon designed or redesigned, made or remade,</u>
- 18 and intended to be fired from the shoulder and designed or

- 1 redesigned and made or remade to use the energy of an explosive
- 2 to fire only a single projectile through a rifled bore for each
- 3 <u>single pull of the trigger.</u>

- 5 <u>"Semiautomatic assault rifle." A semiautomatic rifle capable</u>
- 6 of holding more than five rounds of ammunition in a fixed or
- 7 <u>detachable magazine.</u>
- 8 "Semiautomatic rifle." A repeating rifle that utilizes a
- 9 portion of the energy of a firing cartridge to extract the fired
- 10 cartridge case and chamber the next round and that requires a
- 11 <u>separate pull of the trigger to fire each cartridge.</u>

- 13 Section 2. Section 6111(g) of Title 18 is amended by adding
- 14 a paragraph and the section is amended by adding a subsection to
- 15 read:
- 16 § 6111. Sale or transfer of firearms.

- 18 (c.1) Semiautomatic assault rifles. -- No person shall sell or
- 19 <u>transfer a semiautomatic assault rifle to an individual under 21</u>
- 20 years of age.

- 22 (q) Penalties.--

- 24 (1.1) Any person, licensed dealer, licensed manufacturer
- or licensed importer who knowingly or intentionally sells,
- delivers or transfers a semiautomatic assault rifle to any
- 27 <u>person, purchaser or transferee who is unqualified or</u>
- ineligible to control, possess or use a semiautomatic assault
- 29 <u>rifle under this chapter commits a felony of the third degree</u>
- and shall in addition be subject to revocation of the license
