AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
3 articles, providing for the offense of carrying firearms
4 while under the influence of alcohol.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 6108.1. Carrying firearms while under the influence of
10 alcohol.

11 (a) Offense defined.--It shall be unlawful for a person who
12 holds a license issued under this chapter to carry a firearm on
13 or about the person to carry a firearm after imbibing a
14 sufficient amount of alcohol such that the alcohol concentration
15 in the person's blood or breath is at least 0.08%.

16 (b) Grading.--

17 (1) A person who violates subsection (a) commits a
18 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to

1 pay a fine of \$100. A first offense may also result in the
2 suspension of the license issued under this chapter for a
3 period not to exceed three years.

4 (2) A second or subsequent offense under subsection (a)
5 constitutes a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall be
6 punishable by a fine of \$500. A second or subsequent offense
7 shall also result in the suspension of the license issued
8 under this chapter for a period of at least three years or in
9 the permanent revocation of the license.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
