It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11-47-3.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-47 entitled

2 "Weapons" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>11-47-3.1. Carrying a stolen firearm when committing a crime of violence. --</u> No

4 person shall commit a crime of violence when armed with or having available a stolen firearm.

5 Every person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished: (1) for the first conviction

6 by imprisonment for not less than five (5) nor more than ten (10) years; (2) for a second

conviction under this section by imprisonment for not less than fifteen (15) nor more than twenty

8 (20) ten (10) years; and (3) for a third or subsequent conviction under this section by

9 imprisonment for not less than twenty (20) fifteen (15) years and may be imprisoned for life. The

sentence imposed shall be consecutive to the underlying sentence for the crime of violence, and

11 the person shall not be afforded the benefits of deferment of sentence, suspension of sentence or

12 <u>parole</u>.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENSES -- WEAPONS

This act would set new penalties for first, second and third convictions for carrying a stolen firearm while committing a crime of violence, and would deny the person so convicted any benefit of deferment of sentence, suspension of sentence or parole.
