# House Bill 1052

Introduced by: **Representative** Aylward

1 **An Act to place limitations on the enforcement of federal laws and directive related**  
 2 **to firearms and ammunition.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added:**

5 No state agency, political subdivision, or any elected or appointed official or  
 6 employee of this state or of a political subdivision may contract with or in any manner  
 7 provide assistance to a federal agency or official with respect to the enforcement of a  
 8 federal statute, regulation, or executive order, which imposes a prohibition, restriction, or  
 9 requirement that does not exist under the laws of this state and relates to the sale,  
 10 transfer, ownership, or possession of:

11 (1) A firearm, or any component or accessory; or

12 (2) Ammunition, or any component or accessory.

13 **Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added:**

14 Any elected or appointed official or employee of this state or of a political  
 15 subdivision who knowingly violates section 1 of this Act is subject to:

16 (1) A civil penalty in the amount of \$1000 for a first violation; and

17 (2) A Class 1 misdemeanor for a second or subsequent violation.

18 Any civil penalty collected by a court in accordance with this section must be paid  
 19 into the state general fund.

20 **Section 3. That a NEW SECTION be added:**

21 This Act does not apply to any contract requiring the provision of assistance in the  
 22 enforcement of a federal statute, regulation, or executive order, if the contract was  
 23 entered into before July 1, 2022.
