1 (b) Persons holding a valid concealed carry permit 2 issued by the state of Wyoming under W.S. 6-8-104(a)(ii) 3 may carry a concealed weapon in the following places: 4 5 (i) Any meeting of a governmental entity; 6 7 (ii) Any meeting of the legislature or a 8 committee thereof; 9 (iii) Any public school, college or professional 10 athletic event whether or not related to firearms; 11 12 (iv) Any public elementary or secondary school 13 14 facility; and 15 16 (v) Any public college or university facility without the written consent of the security service of the 17 college or university. 18 19 20 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to: 21 22 (i) Alter concealed weapon prohibitions relating to courtrooms as specified in W.S. 6-8-104(t)(iii); 23
