Wearing or carrying concealed weapons; 13 penalties; exceptions; permits.

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1 2 (i) The items listed in subsection (d) of this 3 section; 4 5 (ii) Proof of residency in a form acceptable to the attorney general that shows the applicant meets the 6 requirements specified in subsection (b) of this section; 7 8 9 (iii) Certification of the applicant's active 10 military service outside the state; 11 12 (iv) A notarized affidavit from the applicant 13 testifying in writing that the statements in the application are true and accurate. The affidavit required 14 15 by this paragraph subjects the applicant to criminal 16 prosecution under W.S. 6-5-303; and 17 18 (v) Any other information required by rule and 19 regulation of the attorney general. 20 Section 2. The attorney general shall promulgate 21 22 rules and regulations necessary to implement this act by July 1, 2016. 23
