(c) The sale, transfer, purchase, delivery, taxation, 7 manufacture, ownership, transportation, storage, use and 8 9 possession of firearms, weapons and ammunition shall be 10 authorized, regulated and prohibited by the state, and regulation thereof is preempted by the legislature of the 11 12 state of Wyoming. Except as authorized by W.S. 13 15-1-103(a)(xviii) and 21-3-132, no state agency or entity, 14 city, town, county, political subdivision or any other entity shall authorize, regulate or prohibit the sale, 15 16 transfer, purchase, delivery, taxation, manufacture, 17 ownership, transportation, storage, use, carrying or 18 possession of firearms, weapons, accessories, components or 19 ammunition except as specifically provided by this chapter. 20 This section shall not affect zoning or other ordinances 21 which encompass firearms businesses along with other businesses. Zoning and other ordinances which are designed 22 23 for the purpose of restricting or prohibiting the sale,
