Limiting firearm seizure and regulation during emergencies.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to homeland security; specifying additional
2 limitations on the exercise of powers related to homeland
3 security and states of emergency concerning firearms; and
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-13-104(e)(ii)(intro), (A), (C) and
9 by creating new paragraphs (iii) through (vi) is amended to
10 read:

12 **19-13-104. Powers of governor generally; director,**
13 **office of homeland security.**

14

1 (e) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to
2 confer upon the governor, the director, the executive heads
3 or governing bodies of the political subdivisions of the
4 state, sheriffs, chiefs of police or any employee or agent
5 of the state or any governmental unit within the state the
6 power to:

7

8 (ii) Impose additional restrictions as to the
9 lawful possession, permitting, transfer, sale, carrying,
10 storage, display or use of:

11

12 (A) Firearms or other personal weapons;

13

14 (C) Components of firearms, personal
15 weapons or ammunition.

16

17 (iii) Close or limit the operating hours of any
18 person or entity engaged in the lawful selling or servicing
19 of any firearm, ammunition or other personal weapon, or any
20 component thereof, unless the closing or limitation of
21 operating hours applies equally to all forms of commerce
22 within the jurisdiction of the state, political subdivision
23 or governmental entity;

2 (iv) Close or limit the operating hours of any
3 indoor or outdoor shooting range;

4

5 (v) Place restrictions or quantity limitations
6 on any entity regarding the lawful sale or servicing of any
7 firearm, ammunition or personal weapon, or any component
8 thereof;

9

10 (vi) Suspend or revoke a permit to carry a
11 concealed weapon issued pursuant to W.S. 6-8-401, unless
12 the suspension or revocation is authorized and completed
13 pursuant to W.S. 6-8-401.

14

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2021.
