- 2 possession of firearms by a person on the terrorist watch
- 3 list as specified; modifying concealed weapon permit
- 4 eligibility; and providing for an effective date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-8-205 is created to read:

10 6-8-205. Firearm purchases and possession prohibited.

- 12 No person shall purchase or possess a firearm in this state
- 13 if the person is currently named on the consolidated
- 14 terrorist watch list maintained by the terrorist screening
- 15 center of the federal bureau of investigation.

2 **Section 2.** W.S. 6-8-104(b)(v)(B), (C) and by creating

3 a new subparagraph (D) and 6-8-404(c)(ii), (iii), by

4 creating a new paragraph (iv), (d)(iii), (iv) and by

5 creating a new paragraph (v) are amended to read:

7 6-8-104. Wearing or carrying concealed weapons;

8 penalties; exceptions; permits.

10 (b) The attorney general is authorized to issue permits to carry a concealed firearm to persons qualified 11 12 as provided by this subsection. The attorney general shall 13 promulgate rules necessary to carry out this section no later than October 1, 1994. Applications for a permit to 14 15 carry a concealed firearm shall be made available and 16 distributed by the division of criminal investigation and 17 local law enforcement agencies. The permit shall be valid throughout the state for a period of five (5) years from 18 19 the date of issuance. The permittee shall carry the permit, 20 together with valid identification at all times when the 21 permittee is carrying a concealed firearm and shall display 22 both the permit and proper identification upon request of

any peace officer. The attorney general through the 1 2 division shall issue a permit to any person who: 3 4 (∇) Has not been: 5 (B) Convicted of a felony violation of the 6 Wyoming Controlled Substances Act of 1971, W.S. 35-7-1001 7 8 through 35-7-1057 or similar laws of any other state or the United States relating to controlled substances and has not 9 10 been pardoned; or 11 12 (C) Convicted of a misdemeanor violation of the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act of 1971, W.S. 13 35-7-1001 through 35-7-1057 or similar laws of any other 14 15 state or the United States relating to controlled 16 substances within the one (1) year period prior to the date 17 on which application for a permit under this section is 18 submitted; - or 19 20 (D) Currently named on the consolidated 21 terrorist watch list maintained by the terrorist screening 22 center of the federal bureau of investigation. 23
