A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to concealed weapons; removing the state  
2 residency requirement for a person carrying a concealed  
3 firearm without a permit who meets the other statutory  
4 criteria; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-8-104(a)(iv) is amended to read:

9

10 **6-8-104. Wearing or carrying concealed weapons;**  
11 **penalties; exceptions; permits.**

1           (a) A person who wears or carries a concealed deadly  
2 weapon is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of  
3 not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00),  
4 imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6)  
5 months, or both for a first offense, or a felony punishable  
6 by a fine of not more than two thousand dollars  
7 (\$2,000.00), imprisonment for not more than two (2) years,  
8 or both, for a second or subsequent offense, unless:

10           (iv) The person does not possess a permit issued  
11 under this section, but is a resident of the United States  
12 and otherwise meets the requirements specified in  
13 paragraphs ~~(b)(i)~~ (b)(ii) through (vi), (viii) and (ix) of  
14 this section and possession of the firearm by the person is  
15 not otherwise unlawful.

17           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2021.
